Autumn Term Reports

This year, we have amended our approach to reporting for student progress so that the information is easier to find. Instead of needing to access the web version of 'MyChildAtSchool', reports are now available on the app in the 'Reports' section.

The reports detail the percentage your child scored in their Autumn Term assessment, and what progress they are making as a result. An explanation of how the progress statements are arrived at is included on the report. You will also see your child's attendance percentage for the year to date, as well as their reading age from their most recent reading test (if available).

We continue to look at how we report to parents/ carers, and look to further develop this.

In the meantime, I have been made aware that 'MyChildAtSchool' has not notified a number of parents that reports from the Autumn Term are now available in the 'reports' section of the app. These were published at the very start of this term, and I apologise if you have not had the opportunity to see this.
