I am thrilled to share the details for this year's Year 11 Prom. The 2025 prom will be held at Hockwold Hall on Wednesday, 9th July, with the theme of "Casino Royal."

Arrivals will take place between 6:00 PM and 7:00 PM, where students will have the opportunity to be photographed in front of the beautiful hall and gardens alongside their choice of transportation, whether that's a fancy car, tractor, or horsebox. Family and friends are welcome to join in the photos, but we kindly ask that this is kept brief to ensure a smooth and timely arrival for everyone. For students who prefer a less grand entrance, the car park will be available for drop-offs. The event will officially begin at 7:00 PM with welcome drinks and a chance to mingle.

The evening will feature a BBQ, a performance by the school band, themed entertainment, and a DJ. There will also be a soft drink-only bar where students can purchase refreshments. The event will conclude at 10:00 PM, so please ensure transport is arranged accordingly.

Our prom committee has been working hard on fundraising and has already raised a significant amount, which will help keep ticket prices as low as possible. A £10 deposit will be required via My Child At School to reserve a ticket for the prom. This will allow us to know the number of attendees and plan the event accordingly. The final ticket price will be determined by how much additional fundraising takes place but will be capped at £35, with the price being reduced if we raise more funds.

Additionally, students can earn £1.50 for every five lunchtime-to-after-school revision sessions they attend. The amount they earn will be deducted from the final price of the ticket before any remaining payments are due.
