Year 10 Mocks: June 2025

I am writing to you to confirm the details of Year 10's mock examinations. We are really looking forward to seeing how the students perform in these exams: they are crucial in letting us know how students are performing so far, and how we can support students as they move into Year 11. Results will be released before the end of the summer term to support with students' own revision and study.

The mock exams will be taking place from the $10^{th} - 27^{th}$ June and will enable students, for the first time, to experience how the external mock process happens and begin to grow more comfortable with the rules and regulations.

This will be followed by a larger formal mock season in November 2025, and a smaller, focused mock season in February 2026, and I will confirm the specific dates and papers/ subjects with you as soon
